Standards and Expectations - Parent Commitment

1. I will enjoy my child's opportunity to experience the benefits of soccer and will trust in my child's ability to have fun as well as to perform and achieve excellence on his/her own.
2. I will be a role model of good sportsmanship and help my child learn positive lessons from both winning and losing with a team as well as from individual accomplishments and mistakes.
3. I will respect my child's teammates, coaches, and fellow parents as well as the players, parents, and coaches from opposing teams.
4. I will respect the game officials and refrain from any communication with referees before, during, or after a game.
5. When I comment from the sidelines, it is with encouragement; I will refrain from sideline coaching of my child or any other player.
6. I will make every effort to insure my child participates in all practices and games; when it is not possible, I will inform the coach in advance.
7. I will respect the fields and facilities made available for soccer, refrain from leaving trash, and will not bring dogs to practices or games per school district and City of Walnut Creek regulations.
8. If I have on-field concerns, I will abide by the "24 hour policy" through which I will approach coaches no less than 24 hours after a game or practice.
9. I will take constructive concerns first to my child's coach, then if needed, to the Age Group Coordinator; the House Director and the Executive Director are also available to help beyond that.
10. I will be responsible to report to WCSC any perceived misconduct by a coach, player, parent, or official so it can be dealt with in the appropriate manner.
