Be reasonable in your demands on your players time, energy, enthusiasm and performance on the field.

Teach your players to abide by the Laws of the Game at all times.

NEVER argue with a referee's decision.

Respect the ability of opponents, the judgement of referees and opposing coaches

Ensure that your players soccer experience is fun and enjoyable (winning is only part of this).
Players should never be yelled at or ridiculed for making mistakes or losing a game.

Be generous with your praise when it is deserved. Children need a coach that sets good example for the team.

Stay educated on principles of coaching and child development.

Verify equipment and playing facilities meet safety standards and be appropriate for the age and ability of your players.

Follow the advice of a physician when determining when an injured child is ready to play again
